# I. RIGHTS OF LGBTI+ PERSONS

#### Previous recommendations:

 Adopt marriage equality legislation, extending full marriage rights to same-sex couples (noted), Initiate again a plan to adopt a national action plan on lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and intersex equality

#### Main issues:

Absence of legal recognition of same-sex couples, absence of a framework document for the protection of the rights of LGBTI+ people, legislative attempts to restrict the rights of LGBTI+ people, inadequate accessibility of health care in relation to transition, restricted blood donation by gay and bisexual men



# I. RIGHTS OF LGBTI+ PERSONS

## RECOMMENDATIONS

- Adopt a comprehensive action plan for the rights of LGBTI+ persons, which would be a result of a participatory process.
- Adopt measures to improve accessibility of medical transition and legal gender recognition.
- Remove the restriction of blood donations by gay and bisexual men on the basis of sexual orientation alone.



### II. MEDIA FREEDOM

#### Previous recommendations:

 Respect, protect and promote freedom of expression of journalists and media actors and take all necessary steps to ensure that the media can perform its work safely

#### Main issues:

- Slovak journalists face harrassment by the general public and politicians
- o 66.2% of Slovak journalists experienced an attack or threat in the past 12 months
- 47% of Slovak journalists think the number of incidents has increased over the last
  5 years



# II. MEDIA FREEDOM

# RECOMMENDATIONS

- Adopt legislative measures aimed at increasing safety of journalists and media freedom, including abolishment of the crime of defamation.
- Ensure available and efficient protection of journalists to prevent and investigate threats and violence, including from politicians.



# III. HUMAN RIGHTS DEFENDER

No previous recommendations.

#### Main issues:

- Lack of systemic funding and fragmented regulation
- Not including NGOs and human rights defenders in participatory processes
- Prevalence of hate speech and harrassment of human rights defenders including from politicians



# III. HUMAN RIGHTS DEFENDER

# RECOMMENDATIONS

- Ensure efficient protection of human rights defenders to prevent and investigate threats, violence and other restrictions of rights, including from politicians.
- Adopt sustainable and long-term institutional and financial support for civil society organizations, including those working on gender equality and LGBTI+ rights.
