 Recommendations
- 9 Recommendations for LGBTIQ+ Rights
- Absence of Recommendations in 2009 and 2013 UPR Cycles
- Ongoing Pattern of Denial and Lack of Recognition

LGBTIQ+ Rights in Azerbaijan

- Worrying environment for the LGBTIQ+ citizens in Azerbaijan
- ILGA's reports: Consistent lowest ranking in safeguarding LGBTIQ+ rights
- Frequent arbitrary arrests and mistreatment by law enforcement authorities

Findings of Queerdian's Joint Submission to UPR

- Misuse of anti-public morality laws leading to unlawful arrests and detention
- Emotional and physical abuse faced by LGBTIQ+ detainees
- Forced medical exams without consent
 - Incidents of 2017 and 2019
 - Large-scale police raids targeting LGBTIQ+ citizens
 - Ongoing fear and vulnerability within the LGBTIQ+ community

Hate Speech & Hate Crimes

- Lack of inclusion of gender identity and sexual orientation in hate speech-related laws
- Increased level of hate speech and hate crimes in media and society
- Example: Murder of Avaz Hafizli and inadequate punishment due to lack of hate crime classification

Data Gap

- Absence of data concerning LGBTIQ+ citizens within state institutions
- Factors contributing to the data gap and state's perception

Queerdian's Recommendations

- Comprehensive Anti-Discrimination Strategy
- Ratification of Istanbul Convention
- Regulations for Data Collection
- Amendments to Criminal Code
- Establishment of LGBTIQ+ Rights Monitoring Body within Ombudsperson Office
