Ecuador is starting a process for a new constitution and has requested the support of FAO for the preparation of a document on the right to adequate food to be presented to the constitution assemblyⁱ. The government of Ecuador also prepared a national plan for social development, which includes elements related to rural development and the right to food. A national training session and awareness workshop on the right to food were conducted.
