Although Brazil has taken measures to broaden women's access to natal and obstetric care, its *Rede Cegonha* (Stork Network programme) is principally focused on the healthcare needs of women who have decided to carry their pregnancies to term, *i.e.*, women who have chosen to have children. *Rede Cegonha* entirely fails to address the healthcare needs of women wishing to terminate their pregnancies.

This has real and adverse implications for the quality and extent of women's maternal healthcare, since it leads to at least a significant reduction of, and in some cases the effective denial of, women's reproductive health rights. For example:

- (i) there are limited public education programmes and limited access to information about family planning options, and public authorities such as hospitals do not provide facilities and appropriate prenatal care to enable women to exercise their reproductive rights;
- (ii) public authorities provide little or no information regarding abortion, even when it would be lawful such as where a woman has been raped; and,
- (iii) women seeking abortions are often forced to wait long hours before a dilatation and curettage.

In addition, although Brazil has reduced its overall average maternal mortality ratio, it has not provided information on whether it has reduced the maternal mortality rates in the rural and poorer areas of Brazil that have historically had the highest maternal mortality ratio.
