ADVANCE QUESTIONS TO YEMEN (SECOND BATCH)

AUSTRIA

- What steps has the Government already taken and what steps are planned to be taken to ensure unimpeded access to humanitarian aid and to put an end to targeting, damaging or destroying of objects indispensable to the civilian population?
- Austria would also be interested to hear what steps the Government plans to take in order to implement the recommendations of the UN Group of Eminent Experts.
- Regarding the committee to investigate arbitrary detention set up by the Government in June 2017, we would be interested to receive information on the committee's conclusions and on the question if these conclusions have already been made public.

SLOVENIA

- Slovenia pays special attention to the psychosocial well-being of children, including those in armed conflict. In its national report, the Yemeni government specifies the actions taken to raise awareness and on training on well-being of displaced children and children soldiers. Can Yemeni government provide information on its activities to promote and ensure psychosocial well-being of other children affected by conflict as well as on how many children soldiers and displaced children have been included in its initiatives aimed at providing psychological support and rehabilitation?
- In the national report the Yemeni government enlists several adopted national action plans. It also states that it is committed to equality and empowerment of women. The government also reports that it seeks to promote women's participation in public life and to mainstream gender in the state budget. Can the Yemeni government provide examples on how its budged is gender sensitive?

GERMANY

- What measures has the Government taken to release or bring to trial those held in disclosed and undisclosed detention centers throughout territory controlled by the Government?
- What steps has the Government of Yemen taken to follow-up on allegations of torture in detention centers in areas under its control?
- What measures has the Government taken to protect migrants from violence and exploitation in areas under its control?
