

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. The UK government needs to immediately:

2. Remove the appointment of commissioners, independent reviewers and similar positions e.g. issue 'tsars' from ministerial fiat and create appointment procedures that are independent of government interference. Candidates must be able to demonstrate professional fitness for posts and conflicts of interest, accusation of discriminatory bias etc. must be thoroughly investigated before any appointments are made by the new appointment process.
3. Set about reviews of the aforementioned existing legislation in terms of their impact on the UK's obligations under various human rights norms.
4. Initiate an in-depth review of the impact, including the manifest harms of institutionalised racism, of the existing CT regime, including but not solely the Prevent program.
5. Halt plans to introduce any more CT legislation until such time as a properly independent review of the current CT regime is undertaken.
6. Halt the introduction of the Police Crime Sentencing and Courts Bill.
