New Human Rights Strategy and Action Plan

RECOMMENDATION

- Develop a new strategy and action plan with concrete measures to achieve strong and comprehensive human rights protection in Sweden.

Strengthening of Indigenous Sami people's human rights

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Ensure, in close consultation with the Sami, that land use decisions in their traditional areas do not harm Sami culture, languages or identity.
- Ensure that legislation and law enforcement are fully in line with international law and indigenous rights standards, including the principle of free and prior informed consent (FPIC).

Strengthening of Tornedalians, Kvens and Lantalaïset's human rights

RECOMMENDATION

- Fully implement the proposals of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission for Tornedalians, Kvens and Lantalaïset.

Inclusion of disability as a protected ground in hate crime legislation

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Introduce disability as a protected ground in hate crime legislation.
- Strengthen the involvement of persons with disabilities, including children and young people, in the implementation of the CRPD.
