Previous recommendations

Refugees and immigrant rights should be strengthened.

Recommended by Montenegro, Georgia, South Korea, Portugal and Ukraine

Supported by the Danish Government

1. New rules on expulsion

- Lack of respect for international human rights law practice
- Clear breach of international law

2. Conditions on return centers

- Increased duty to report
- Lack of consideration for right to private and family life
- Lack of consideration for the rights of the child

Recommendations from DRC Danish Refugee Council

- National legislation on expulsion is always in full accordance with both international law and jurisprudence when adopted, which means that the future rules on expulsion should clearly reference to Denmark's respect for international human rights law.
- Living conditions at return centers are in full accordance with the right to private and family life and the best interest of the child, which means that the current rules of reporting daily should be withdrawn and the possibility to have contact with your family should be a priority.
