60.54 Further provide information on other measures, and on developing of an action plan on racism in the next periodic report (Georgia);

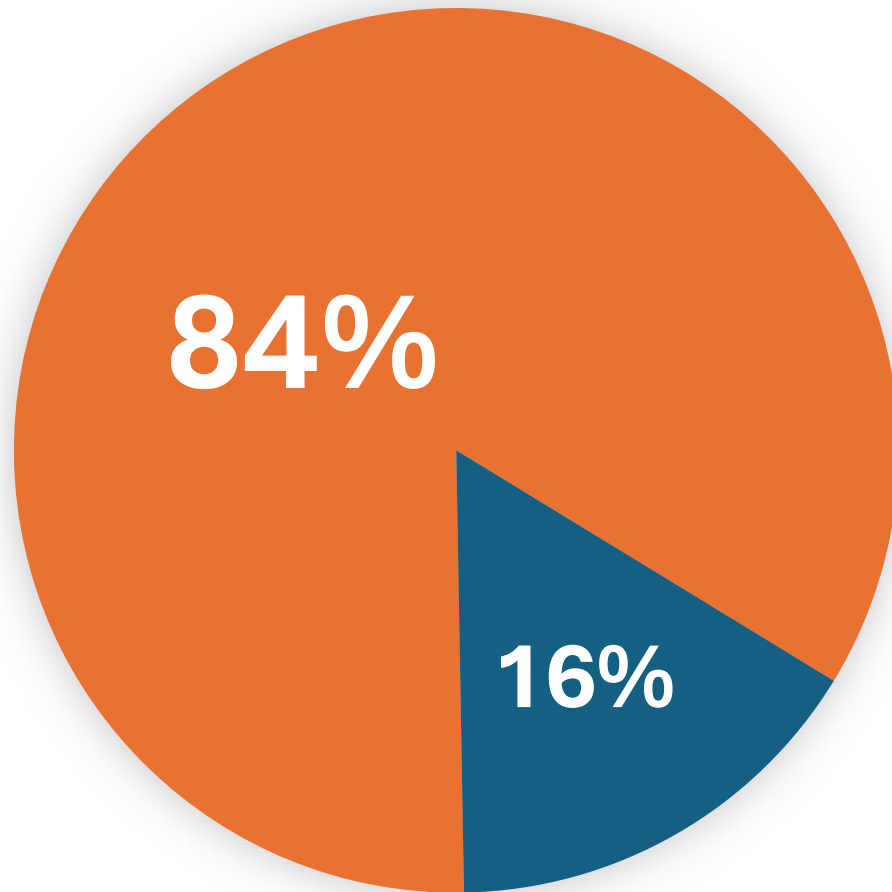

“The initiatives to monitor racism, as set out in the Action Plan against Racism, should be made permanent. The plan should be expanded to address discrimination and hatred against all religious and ethnic minorities, including Muslims, who represent a large minority group in the Danish society. A definition of racial discrimination must be included in the Plan.”
