## ADVANCE QUESTIONS TO CÔTE D'IVOIRE-Add.2

## THE NETHERLANDS

- The Ivorian authorities have, in the months preceding the intended November 2009 presidential elections, gone through extensive efforts to establish a well founded voters list. The pre-identification procedures identified a group of about 1,9 million persons that are undocumented. Could the Government of Côte d'Ivoire indicate on how it pretends to avoid statelessness for these persons in conformity with the Convention on the Reduction of Statelessness?
- The stakeholders report (para. 28) indicates that the living conditions in the prisons remain deplorable. The national report (para. 146) mentions several legislative reforms that are under way. Could the Government of Côte d'Ivoire indicate the nature and progress of these reforms?
- The National Human Rights Commission submitted its first annual report on 29 June in which it made recommendations to the Government aimed at further strengthening its effectiveness, autonomy and independence, in conformity with the Paris Principles (OHCHR compilation, para. 5). What is the state of affairs regarding the implementation of these recommendations?

## **HUNGARY**

- Violence against children and child labor is a widespread phenomenon within the society. Violence against girls at schools forced many of them to leave the educational institutions. How does the government intend to handle this problem?
- What kind of measures does the government wish to take for the better operation of the judiciary?
- The government accepted the authority of the ICC for the crimes committed after 2002, but it has not yet ratified the Statute of the ICC. What kind of steps has the government already taken for the preparation of the ratification?
