LIECHTENSTEIN

- Liechtenstein recognizes Guatemala's commitment to preventing and ending mass atrocities, as evidenced by its joining the Code of Conduct regarding Security Council action against genocide, crimes against humanity or war crimes, as elaborated by the Accountability, Coherence and Transparency Group (ACT). Liechtenstein recognizes Guatemala's commitment to international criminal justice, as evidenced by its ratification of the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court (ICC). **What steps has Guatemala taken to ratify the Kampala amendments to the Rome Statute on the crime of aggression?**
