LIECHTENSTEIN

- What steps has Pakistan taken to ratify the Rome Statute in its 2010 version?
- What steps has Pakistan taken to join the Code of Conduct regarding Security Council action against genocide, crimes against humanity or war crimes, as elaborated by the Accountability, Coherence and Transparency Group (ACT)?
- What Steps has Pakistan taken to ratify the Protocol to Prevent, Suppress and Punish Trafficking in Persons, Especially Women and Children, supplementing the United Nations Convention against Transnational Organized Crime ('Palermo Protocol')?

PORTUGAL

• Has the State-under-review established a dedicated 'national mechanism for implementation, reporting and follow-up' (NMIRF) covering UPR recommendations, but also recommendations/observations generated by the UN human rights Treaty Bodies, the Special Procedures and relevant regional mechanisms? If so, could the State-under-review briefly share its experience on creating such mechanism, including challenges faced and lessons learnt, as well as any plans or needs to strengthen the NMIRF in the future?

SPAIN

- What measures have the Pakistani authorities taken to build the capacity of the police and the judiciary to work on cases of violence against women in a gender-sensitive manner?
- The provincial assembly of Sindh approved in 2016 the Hindu Marriage Act which allows Hindus, Sikhs and Parsis to register their marriages. What other measures, at a federal and a provincial level, are being taken in order to ensure the fundamental rights of people belonging to religious minorities such as Ahmedis, Christians, Sikhs or Hindus?
- What measures is the government of Pakistan taking to ensure the accessibility of government and public buildings, accessible infrastructure, roads, transport, and access to information in accordance with the dispositions contained in the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities?
