

**Appendix I: NGOs declared unlawful by the Israeli authorities under the 1945 Emergency Regulations (November/2015)**

Organization	Description
1. Iqra' (Read): The Association for Advancing Education in the Arab Community	Iqra' is a university students' body that was founded in 1995 to support the educational and social life of the Palestinian students in Israel, by organizing training courses and social events and by providing scholarships. Iqra' serves about 10,000 students.
2. The Islamic Organization Kofr-Kana	The organization administers a number of kindergartens, an elementary and high school (total 1,500 student), and other social services in Qana of the Galilee (Kofr-Kanna).
3. The Humanitarian Relief Fund	Established in 2003, the Fund supports mainly orphans and people in need through charity donations. The Fund supports 23,000 orphans in addition to hundreds of other families.
4. H'iraa' Association for Memorizing the Quran	H'iraa' works among 10,000 elementary and high school students to help them memorize the Quran and provides educational support to them.
5. The Negev Association for the Human and the Land	Founded in 2001, it provides support and assistance to the 70,000 residents of 45 "illegal" unrecognized villages who lack all basic social services and infrastructure.
6. Yafa Organization for Charity 7.	Founded in 2001, the organization works among the community of Jaffa by providing health and educational support projects, assisting 150 orphans and other people in need.
8. Al-Takaful "Social Solidarity" Foundation	<b>Founded in 1997, the foundation focuses on religious institutions and on the support of the personnel who work in these institutions, such as Imams and preachers.</b>

<p>9. &amp; 10.: E'mar Center for Economic Development and Empowerment, and Izdiharuna for supporting small businesses</p>	<p>Founded in 2008, E'mar Center focuses on the economic equality and development of the Palestinian minority in Israel, through a number of projects that relate to marketing, investment, import and export, as well as by providing loans and support to small businesses through its special Fund (Izdiharuna), and its forum of businessmen.</p>
<p>11. Al-Risala, Publishing and Media</p>	<p>Al-Risala focuses on media and publication affairs that relate to the religious and socio-political affairs of the Palestinian communities in Israel. Al-Risala issues, since 1989, the newspaper <i>Sawt Al-haq Wal-Huriya</i> (The Voice of Right and Freedom), administers a news website, and publishes the bi-weekly magazine <i>Ishraqa</i> (7,000 copies).</p>
<p>12. The Bayariq of the Haram al-Sharif</p>	<p>Al-Bayariq is a campaign to facilitate the worship opportunities of Palestinian citizens of Israel in Al-Aqsa mosque by providing transportation services to Jerusalem.</p>
<p>13. Al-Masra Fund</p>	<p><b>Al-Masra is a charity fund that supports civil society institutions in educational, cultural and social fields in Israel.</b></p>
<p>14. Al-Aqsa Institute</p>	<p>Al-Aqsa Institute focuses its operation around the affairs of Al-Aqsa mosque by monitoring any violations related to access to the mosque and renovating abandoned Christian and Muslim religious sites and cemeteries.</p>
<p>15. Nour Center for Islamic Research and Studies</p>	<p>A research center that touched upon historical, geographical, and social dimensions related to the Palestinians in Israel, as well as on documenting and studying the sites of the Islamic endowments.</p>

<p>16. Ribat al-Quds</p>	<p>An organization that focused its operation in Jerusalem by supporting families in need, social and educational projects, and the work of other civil society organizations.</p>
<p>17. Al-Israa' for Social Development. 18. Al-Isra' Fund for Relief and Development 19. Al-Isra' Organization</p>	<p>Al-Israa' group is concerned with raising funds and supporting projects and civil society institutions that work on socio-economic, political, and religious issues.</p>
<p>20. Al-Balagh Media Center</p>	<p>Al-Balagh worked on editing and preparing documentaries based on its research and study center; its work addressed questions related to the socio-economic affairs of the Palestinians.</p>
