Cameroon cooperated with the Human Rights Council notably in denouncing Terrorism in its effort to combat Boko haram. A number of cases were brought against Cameroon before some human rights mechanisms but only 3 were settled by the institutions seized one of which was the Working Group on Arbitrary Detention. The two others were settled by the African Commission on Human and Peoples' Rights. Several other cases are pending before the Human Rights Committee and the African Commission. However, continued cooperation will help consolidate actions to further the protection and promotion of human rights.</p>
